

Forecast FY2022 and Budget for FY2023

In this current financial year, the church, responding to a bountiful previous year and after conducting a rigorous evaluation exercise, has decided to set aside an additional \$2.5m (over and above those already being blessed through COSC and other ministries regularly) to bless others who were affected by the pandemic. With gratitude in our hearts, this sum was distributed to 44 organisations/causes locally and overseas. Therefore, with this additional \$2.5m, we are projecting a deficit of \$1.2m for year ending 31 July 2022.



Budget 2023 sees the Church adjusting to a new normal as Singapore opens up to live with Covid-19. Operating expenditure before accounting for depreciation cost is budgeted at \$18.4m, about 15% higher than the current year's forecast and higher than the pre Covid-19 Opex of \$17.9m in FY2019. The main reason for the increase is because of the full resumption of programmes, adapting and investing in new digital technologies and equipping our congregation with intentional discipleship tools, against a backdrop of increasing staff and other costs.

Based on the budgeted net income of about \$18.2m, we are looking at a deficit of about \$2.1m which includes depreciation of \$1.8m. The church will remain prudent by spending on the essential and continuing to participate in the work for God's kingdom and to bless the least, the last and the lost.
