Journey with our Children & Youth



The Home cares for over 70 children and youths between the ages of 8 and 21 years old, from all races and religions and are referred by the Court and the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF). Most of them are from complex family backgrounds of abuse and neglect. The Home's goal is to transform them into happy and responsible members of their respective families and the community at large.

Besides providing shelter and basic needs for the residents, the Home has a holistic approach towards meeting the emotional and psychological needs through activities and programmes recommended by educators and professionals. A dedicated team which comprises of social workers, counsellors and psychologists, provide support and counselling services for the residents.

The Education department monitors the residents' academic performance at school, and organises tuition for them when required. In the Spiritual aspect, the Home provides support through pastoral care guidance and Christian nurturing by instilling values based on the bible.

The Home was established by the Chen Su Lan Trust and Wesley Methodist Church on 12 March 1968, and registered as a charity on 28 June 1984. The Home is a full member of the National Council of Social Services (NCSS) and awarded the Institution of Public Character (IPC) status.

For the past 54 years, the Home has provided care and shelter for almost a thousand residents. We are grateful for the support from Wesley Methodist Church and we seek your continued support for our children and youths this new year.
